
Spray Buffing/Burnishing Floors








Gather equipment.



Use the proper pad; match the appropriate pad to the equipment and the floor finish. Red pad for spray buffing and high speed pad for burnishing.




Place wet floor signs at all entranceways.




Dust mop and clean the floor first to prevent scratching of the floor finish.




Wear appropriate shoes to avoid slipping.



Apply the solution in a stream or coarse spray in a 10'x10' area when spray buffing.



Buff or burnish the floor to a high shine, overlapping your passes.



Flip or change the pad as needed.



Properly clean and store the equipment.



= Green Cleaning Process

Green Cleaning Tips

- When using a spray buff, apply the solution in a stream or coarse spray to minimize the amount that gets in the air.
- If burnishing, use a vacuum attachment on burnisher, either an active or passive vacuum system.
- Use properly diluted products, preferably through a dispensing system.
- The objective of a green floor maintenance program is to minimize the frequency of stripping or removing floor finish. Having a good maintenance program is crucial to achieving this goal.
