

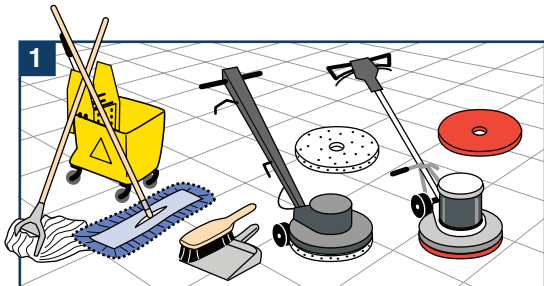
Spray Buffing/Burnishing Floors



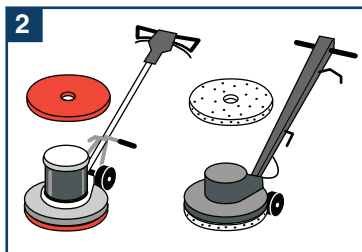

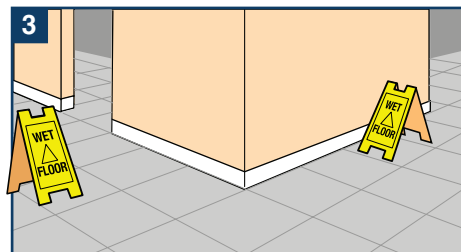

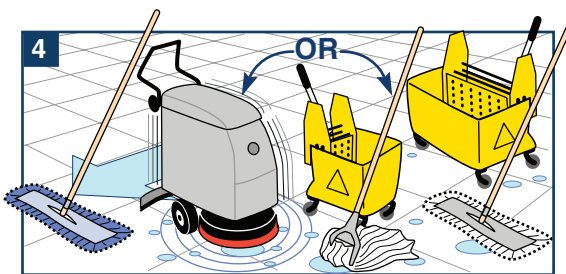
1 Gather equipment.



2 Use the proper pad; match the appropriate pad to the equipment and the floor finish. Red pad for spray buffing and high speed pad for burnishing.



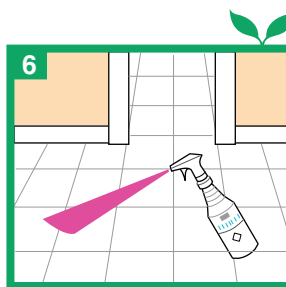
3 Place wet floor signs at all entranceways.



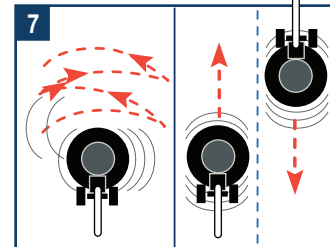
4 Dust mop and clean the floor first to prevent scratching of the floor finish.



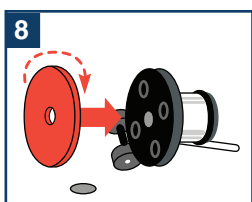
5 Wear appropriate shoes to avoid slipping.



6 Apply the solution in a stream or coarse spray in a 10'x10' area when spray buffing.



7 Buff or burnish the floor to a high shine, overlapping your passes.



8 Flip or change the pad as needed.



9 Properly clean and store the equipment.



Green Cleaning Tips

- When using a spray buff, apply the solution in a stream or coarse spray to minimize the amount that gets in the air.
- If burnishing, use a vacuum attachment on burnisher, either an active or passive vacuum system.
- Use properly diluted products, preferably through a dispensing system.
- The objective of a green floor maintenance program is to minimize the frequency of stripping or removing floor finish. Having a good maintenance program is crucial to achieving this goal.
